



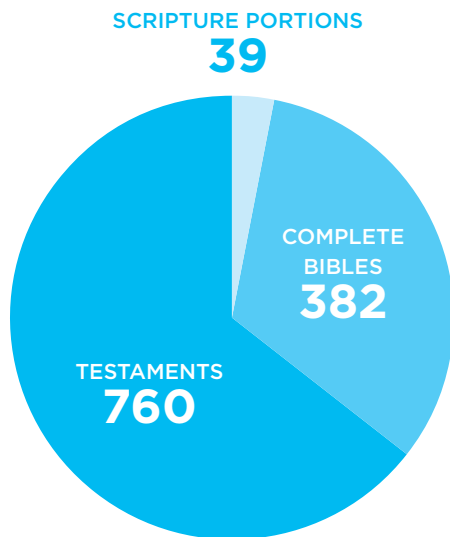

IMPACT STORY



Pastor Albertino Nunes glances up from his laptop at his two colleagues. They're diligently translating the

Bible into their Angolan tongue of Umbundu. The task is urgent; 6 million Umbundu speakers have no Scripture Portions in their heart language. At the end of the day, Albertino saves their work in a cloud-based translation software and heads home.

But for Albertino and his Bible translation team, this workday is anything but typical. "We used

to work by candlelight," recalls Albertino. Not that long ago, he and his fellow translators would huddle around a single keyboard, taking turns typing out their interpretations.

Funding from Every Tribe Every Nation has totally transformed Albertino's workday. "Now we have offices where we work...everyone has their own computers," he explains. In addition to state-of-the-art technology, Albertino and his team receive training in Bible translation from industry experts. "We don't just have to learn from our errors," says Albertino, "Each translator knows how to proceed."

Despite these advances, serious hurdles remain. Recent financial strife in Angola has left translators worried that they will not complete their long-awaited Bible translation as quickly as they hope. "We want to finish the New Testament, maybe this year," says Albertino.

Facing these new challenges, Albertino is hopeful. "There are many difficulties, but many of them have already been solved." With continued financial support, Albertino will soon see the day when his fellow Angolans encounter God's Word in their heart language for the first time. "We are so happy," says Albertino, "We are so grateful."

Worldreader is on a mission to eradicate illiteracy by giving people access to digital books so that they can improve their lives. *Worldreader* reaches nearly 6 million readers in 69 countries and 43 unique languages.
