DIGITAL BIBLE LIBRARY (DBL)

As of May 2015, there are 1,061 licensed Scriptures in the DBL in 836 languages. This represents **4.3 billion speakers**.

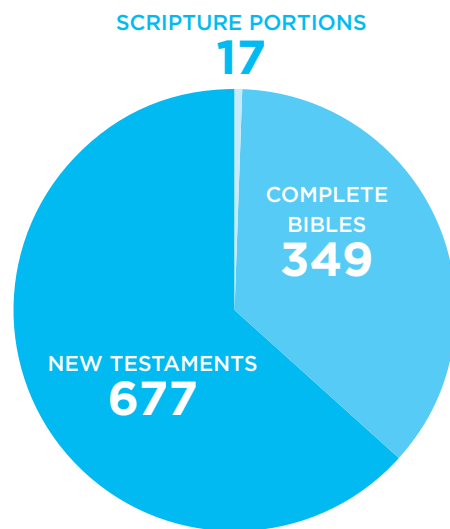

Currently, 11 Intellectual Property Contributors provide digital Scripture to the DBL and 21 Library Card Holders are distributing this Scripture content to more than 150 million people through digital media. Additionally, the DBL currently offers 67 audio Scriptures.



IMPACT STORY

Kalanga is a language spoken by 150,000 people in Botswana. The project to translate Kalanga's first full Bible began in 1984 and is expected to reach completion by the end of this year. The anticipation of the Kalanga full Bible is growing in both rural and urban areas. A common question within the community is now "Where can I get a copy of the Kalanga full Bible?" As a result of this forthcoming translation, the Bakalanga people believe that God speaks their language too. There is a sense of hope, that experiencing the Bible in their heart language will impact the entire community and even lead to moral regeneration. People in the community who have been bound to traditional faiths will have access to Scripture and be introduced to the Christian faith. At a local workshop that brought together more than 10 Kalanga villages, The Board Chairman, Prof. Thapelo Otlogetswe, was able to attend and address the members. He said, "The fruits of your labour in translation work will be enjoyed by the generations to come when they all hear God in Kalanga."



PARTNER PROFILE: LIBRARY CARD HOLDER

Lutheran Bible Translators



Lutheran Bible Translators (LBT) makes God's Word accessible to those who do not yet have it in the language of their hearts. In March of 2014, they became a Library Card Holder in the DBL. LBT translates the Bible for 7 million people in 51 languages across 15 countries. Currently, they have 22 Bible translations in process and 59 Scripture engagement programs.

Upcoming Milestones: *New Testament dedications are planned in 2016 for the Nsenga language (Zambia) and the Kalanga language (Botswana).*
