






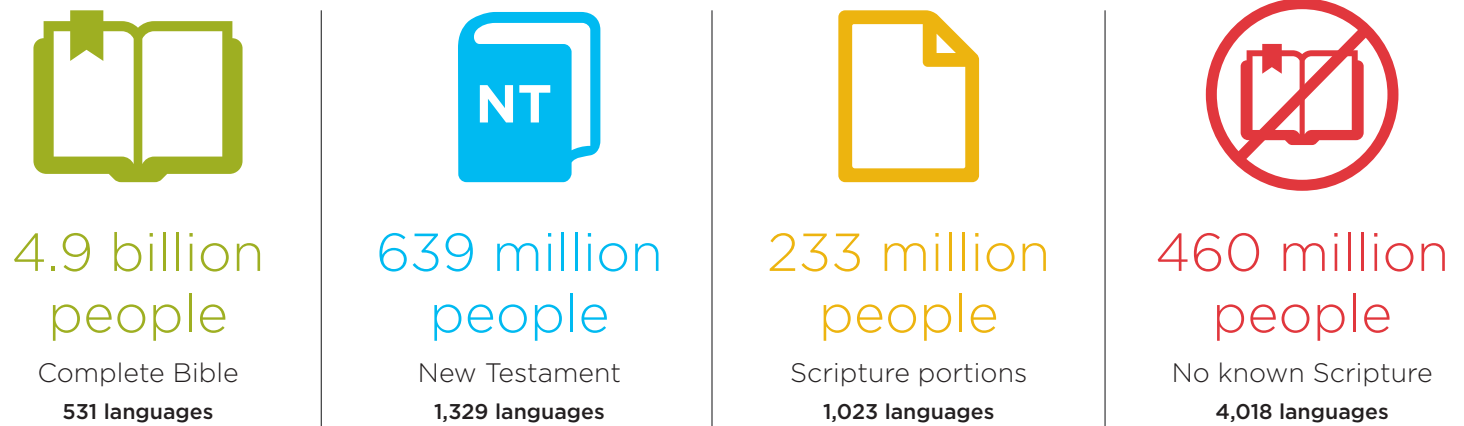

IMPACT STORY

More than 5,000 people in the South Pacific country of New Caledonia speak Ajië as their heart language. Thanks to the Digital Bible Library and YouVersion, they can now use mobile devices to access the Ajië New Testament—previously available only in print.

Following the digital launch of the Ajië New Testament translation, Every Tribe Every Nation partners conducted ParaText software training aimed to accelerate the Ajië Old Testament translation.

The training provides education and insights for translators. One participant explained: "I'm going back with deep insight, happiness [and] with more commitment for Bible ministry."

A training facilitator shared that some participants are returning to a project, "and it's going to move them forward in ways they could never have imagined before they came here."
